## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Manager's Hours

9am to 1pm Monday to Friday.

### Playing Programmes

Monday and Friday afternoons 1pm

Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings 7pm

Players are asked to be seated **15 minutes** before the scheduled start of play.

### Online Bridge run by Wellington Bridge Club

This is available all year courtesy of Wellington Bridge Club using the RealBridge platform. Sessions are available on Friday, Sunday and Monday evenings - see the links on the home page of Wellington Bridge Club's website. Note that any NZ Bridge member is eligible to play in these sessions but only members of Wellington or Hutt Clubs are eligible for prizes.

Other regular HBC sessions may be taken online if face to face bridge is disrupted, for example because of Covid.

### Table Money

Table money is set by the Club and payable at all sessions unless otherwise advised. Payment by direct debit or eftpos is preferred. See the Manager for setting up your direct debit payment.

## Visitors and Guests

Visitors and guests are welcome. They may play up to four times per year. Visitors, guests and their partners will not be eligible for prizes or trophies. Normal table money is payable.

### Affiliated Members

Affiliated members may play up to eight times a year and are recognised with a \* next to their surname in the membership list.

### Results

Results are posted on the Club's website and on the notice board. Any queries should be lodged as soon as possible with the Manager.

### Substitutes

One substitute is allowed for a partnership in a three or four session event. A substitute may not play on behalf of a member present at a session. When two pairs require a substitute, the two individuals present may play together and act as "double substitutes" with the score, if eligible, counting for both pairs.

### Systems

Any system permitted by NZ Bridge may be played at any playing session. However, in fairness to our junior players, it would be appreciated if experienced players did not use more complex systems on Wednesday night.

## **Director**

The Director controls all aspects of play. Please call the Director promptly if there may have been an infringement. Failure to call the Director may mean the forfeiture of rights. The Director's rulings may be appealed. The decision to appeal should be communicated to the Director within 15 minutes of the start of the last board of a session. The Director will then appoint an Appeals Committee from the members playing and the appeal will be heard at the end of play. Should meeting this timeframe not be possible, then the proper course of action is to lodge your query/appeal with the Manager at the first possible opportunity. If appropriate, it will then be referred to the Club's Appeals Director for consideration.

## **Playing Committees**

Each playing programme is supported by a small group known as the playing committee. They organise the tea and coffee, read the weekly notices, and are also responsible for the security of the premises. They are the health and safety wardens for that session.

## **Timekeeping**

This is an important responsibility for each of us. For all sessions apart from Wednesday, the time allowed is 6 minutes to play a board with a minimal "move time" to each new table. This will enable our Directors to ensure that each session proceeds smoothly and as planned.

## **Club Recorder**

The Club Recorder may be approached on a confidential basis to raise a concern about a member's behaviour deemed to be in breach of the Laws of Duplicate Bridge, namely Law 74 'Conduct & Etiquette', and about which the person may not wish to raise with the Director. The Club Recorder may then approach the member concerned or may otherwise deal with the matter as they think fit. If so desired, the identity of the member raising the concern may remain confidential. The Club Recorder does not replace the Director, the appeals system nor the Club's disciplinary process. For further information please contact the Manager.

## **General Conduct**

The prime objective of the Hutt Bridge Club is recognised in our Mission Statement: "To provide people of all ages with an opportunity to participate in a stimulating recreational activity in a supportive and welcoming environment." The Club promotes behaviour consistent with this objective at all times, at the table and around the club.

If a player at the table behaves in an unacceptable manner, please call the Director immediately. Conduct that might interfere with the enjoyment of the game is specifically prohibited by Law 74A and Law 91A gives the Director the authority to impose disciplinary penalties.

For behaviour away from the table that you think is unacceptable, please write to the committee with an account of the incident. The Committee takes all complaints seriously and your privacy is assured.

### Ladder Events

To qualify for a ladder event, each session must be played with a different partner. The best session played by a partnership will be counted. Ladder sessions are marked \* in the programme.

### Teams Event

All entered teams must play each session or arrange substitutes. This event is marked with \*\* in the Tuesday programme. Pre-registration is required to play in this series.

### Swiss Pairs

All registered pairs must play all sessions of a Swiss Pairs event or arrange a substitute. These events are marked with \*\* in the programme. Pre-registration is required to play in these series.

### Lessons and Development Sessions

Lessons and development sessions are run during the year. Watch the noticeboard or contact the Manager for details of times, dates and costs.

Sets of lessons for beginners are scheduled to commence on 26 February (Monday evenings), 8 June (Wednesday afternoons), and 10 June (Monday evenings).

Saturday revision classes cater for newer and less experienced players and include the discussion of interesting boards played the previous week.

Lessons for Improvers and Intermediate players will be held - dates and format to be advised.

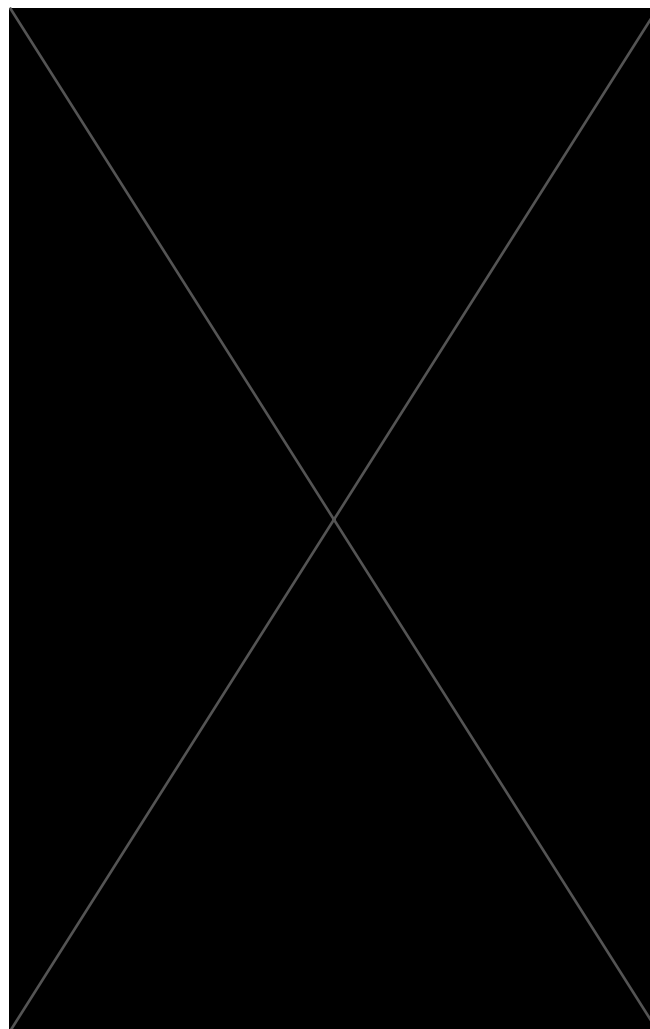
