General information

Playing programmes

- ▶ Monday and Friday afternoons **1pm**
- ▶ Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings **7pm**

Note: Players are asked to be seated **15 minutes** before the scheduled start of play.

Online bridge run by Wellington Bridge Club

This is available all year courtesy of Wellington Bridge Club, using the RealBridge platform. Sessions are available on Friday, Sunday and Monday evenings – see the links on the home page of Wellington Bridge Club's website. **Note:** that any NZ Bridge member is eligible to play in these sessions but only members of Wellington or Hutt Clubs are eligible for prizes.

Other regular HBC sessions may be taken online if face-to-face bridge is disrupted, like it was for COVID-19.

Table money

Table money is set by the Club and is payable at all sessions unless otherwise advised. Our preferred payment method is by direct debit, EFTPOS or online banking. See the Manager for setting up your direct debit payment.

Visitors

Visitors are welcome. They may be invited by a member or the Manager to play up to four times in any financial year. Visitors and their partners will not be eligible for prizes or trophies. Normal table money is payable.

Associate members

Associate members may play up to 10 times a year. They're recognised with a * next to their name in the membership list.

Results

Results are posted on the Club's website and on the notice board. Any queries should be lodged as soon as possible with the Manager.

Substitutes

One substitute is allowed for a partnership in a three or four session event. A substitute may not play on behalf of a member present at a session. When two pairs require a substitute, the two individuals present may play together and act as 'double substitutes' with the score, if eligible, counting for both pairs.

Systems

Any system permitted by NZ Bridge may be played at any playing session. However, in fairness to our junior players, we would appreciate if experienced players did not use more complex systems on Wednesday nights.

Director

The Director controls all aspects of the play. Please call the Director promptly if there may have been an infringement. Failure to call the Director may mean forfeiture of rights.

The Director's rulings may be appealed. A decision to appeal should be communicated to the Director at least 15 minutes before the end of session play. The Director will appoint an Appeals Committee from the members playing and the appeal will be heard at the end of play. If this timeframe isn't possible, you can lodge your query/appeal with the Manager at the first possible opportunity.

Playing committees

Each playing programme is supported by a small playing committee. They organise the tea and coffee, read the weekly notices, and are responsible for the security of the premises. They are the health and safety wardens for that session.

Timekeeping

This is an important responsibility for each of us. For all sessions apart from Wednesday, the time allowed to play a board is 6 minutes, with a minimal move time to each new table. This will help Directors ensure each session runs smoothly and as planned.

General conduct

The Club provides people of all ages with an opportunity to learn and play bridge. Our culture is welcoming, inclusive and supportive.

Dispute resolution

A dispute is a disagreement or conflict involving the Club and/or its members, including allegations that a member or officer has engaged in misconduct. Disputes must be dealt with in a fair, efficient, and effective manner.

Grievances relating to rulings at the bridge table must be dealt with by the NZ Bridge appeal process. Any appeals should be lodged with the relevant director, or as soon as possible with the Club's manager.

A member who has issues with the conduct of another member may approach the Club's mediator for assistance directly or may raise a formal grievance in writing with the committee. The resolution of all disputes must be conducted in a way that is consistent with natural justice. All parties have the right to be heard.

The Club must, as soon as is reasonably practicable after receiving or becoming aware of a complaint, make sure it is investigated and determined. The Club may refer the complaint to the mediator, a subcommittee, or an external party to investigate, report on or to make a decision on the Club's behalf.

Ladder events

To qualify for a ladder event, a person must play each session with a different partner. The best session played by a partnership will be counted. Ladder sessions are marked * in the programme.

The Wednesday night ladder event is for Junior and Novice-grade players.

Teams event

All entered teams must play each session or arrange substitutes. This event is marked with ** in the programme. Pre-registration is required to play in this series.

Swiss Pairs

All registered pairs must play all sessions of a Swiss Pairs event or arrange a substitute. These events are marked with ** in the programme.

Pre-registration is required to play in these series.

Lessons and development sessions

Lessons and development sessions are run during the year. Watch the noticeboard or contact the Manager for details of times, dates and costs.

Sets of lessons for beginners are scheduled to commence on:

- ▶ **16 February** (Monday evenings)
- ▶ **15 June** (Monday evenings).

Saturday revision classes cater for newer and less experienced players and include the discussion of interesting boards played the previous week.
