Players are asked to be seated **15 minutes** before the scheduled start of play.

Director

The Director controls all aspects of play. The Director must be called promptly for any infringement. Failure to call the Director may mean the forfeiture of rights. The Director's rulings may be appealed. The decision to appeal should be communicated to the Director within 15 minutes of the start of the last board of a session. The Director will then appoint an appeals committee from the members playing and the appeal will be heard at the end of play. Should meeting this timeframe not be possible, then the proper course of action is to lodge your query/appeal with the Manager at the first possible opportunity. If appropriate, it will then be referred to the Club's Appeals Director for consideration.

The Director shall not act as a substitute in the event of the non-arrival of a player's partner.

Playing Committees

Each playing programme is managed by a small group known as the playing committee. They support the Director in the running of each session. These members are also responsible for the security of the premises and are the health and safety wardens for that session.

Club Recorder

The Club Recorder may be approached on a confidential basis to raise a concern about a member's behaviour deemed to be in breach of the Laws of Duplicate Bridge, namely Law 74 'Conduct & Etiquette', and about which the person may not wish to raise with the Director. The Club Recorder may then approach the member concerned or may otherwise deal with the matter as they think fit. If so desired, the identity of the member raising the concern may remain confidential. The Club Recorder does not replace the Director, the appeals system nor the Club's disciplinary process. For further information please contact the Manager.

INFORMATION ABOUT PLAYING

Table Money

Table money is set by the Club and payable at all sessions unless otherwise advised. Payment by direct debit or pre-paid tickets is preferred. See the Manager for setting up your direct debit payment or the purchase of tickets.

Visitors and Guests

Visitors and guests are welcome. They may play up to four times per year. Visitors, guests and their partners will not be eligible for prizes or trophies. Normal table money is payable.

Affiliated Members

Affiliated members may play up to eight times a year.

Systems

Any system permitted by NZ Bridge may be played at any playing session. However, in fairness to our junior players, it would be appreciated if experienced players would avoid using more complex systems on Wednesday night.

Results

Results are posted on the Club's website and on the notice board. Any queries should be lodged as soon as possible with the Manager.

Substitutes

One substitute is allowed for a partnership in a three or four

session event. Substitute partnership combinations are included in the eligibility requirements for winning prizes outlined below. A substitute may not play on behalf of a member present at a session. When two pairs require a substitute, the two individuals present may play together and act as "double substitutes" with the score, if eligible, counting for both pairs.

Conduct and Etiquette

The Club promotes acceptable player behaviour at all times. Law 74 of the Laws of Duplicate Bridge covers Conduct and Etiquette. The Director will manage behaviour of players in accordance with this Law.

If a player at the table behaves in an unacceptable manner, the Director must be called immediately. Conduct that might interfere with the enjoyment of the game is specifically prohibited by Law 74A. Law 91A gives the Director the authority to impose disciplinary penalties.

Considerate Play

Six minutes is allocated for the playing of each board and a minute for moving from table to table. The Director is responsible for making sure that, as far as possible, players observe the seven minute guideline and that the session proceeds smoothly and without undue delay.

Eligibility for prizes

A given partnership is eligible to win the main pairs event* and the teams event plus one other series in a playing programme. ***Sadie Williams Memorial Pairs, Shandon Golf Club Pairs, Hutt Pairs, Thursday Pairs, Hutt City New World Pairs.**
